I am delighted to share on behalf of the Staff and EAB at East Garforth, the report from the recent Ofsted inspection on the 13th and 14th June 2017.

East Garforth Primary Academy has received the Ofsted rating of 'Good'. Inspectors acknowledged the significant improvements that have been made by Senior Leaders, the Executive Principal, EAB and Delta Academy Trust since the last inspection.


In the four key areas of the inspection which are Effectiveness of Leadership and Management; Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment, Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare and Outcomes for Pupils, the school received a judgement of 'Good'.

An area for development for East Garforth remains the Early Years Foundation Stage. Inspectors acknowledged the significant improvements that have already been made. In terms of outcomes the inspectors and school both agreed that outcomes could be even better for our very youngest children and this was difficult to achieve in only one year. Inspectors were confident that our programme of development would secure these outcomes in the future.

Key findings from the report are that children make good progress, the teaching of writing is a strength and children display good attitudes, focus on their work and behave well. Disadvantaged pupils and those with Special Educational Needs make good progress due to the targeted use of funding to provide intervention.


