Dear Parents/ Carers,

I am writing to inform you of the schools performance in this year's Statutory Assessments. It is the schools responsibility to report on achievement at the end of each Key Stage.

These assessments take place at the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage which is FS2/Reception Class, at the end of Key Stage 1/Year 2 and the end of Key Stage 2/Year 6. There is also a Phonics screening check that takes place at the end of Year 1

Our youngest children in FS2 are continually monitored for progress throughout the year with a summative judgement made by the class teacher at the end of the year. Year 2 assessments are based on teacher assessment supported by a few short standardised tests which were sat in May. Year 6 assessments are based entirely on test outcomes which were sat in May, except writing that is based on teacher judgement alone.

We are pleased to share the results of these assessments with you below. The schools performance in 2016 has also been included for you comparison along with the National results for 2016. These results indicate the percentage of children who have achieved the age related expected standard for their year group.
