

Maths

Weeks 1-3 **Place Value**

We will be becoming more secure with our knowledge of the number system by developing the counting and ordering of numbers. We will also be practising how to find and recall the number that is one more or less than a given number. The children will also begin to learn how to solve missing number sequences.

Week 5-6: **Addition and Subtraction**

We will be learning how to represent and use number bonds within 10 and then to 20.

We will also be revising how to add single digit numbers and then apply this to solving one step problems.

Week 7: **Shape**

We will be learning how to recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.

Topic

Our topic work this half term will be based around the theme 'If you go down to the woods today'. We will be reading lots of stories based around the forest and finding out more about the animals that live there. We will also be finding out about other habitats around the world. The children will be involved in creating artwork linked to our topic and also learning about significant individuals who have made a name for themselves working with animals.

Weeks 1-3, Fiction: We will be using the story of Hansel and Gretel as a story stimulus for innovating and inventing our own stories.
