Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of column addition and subtraction where appropriate.
Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers to a calculation.
Solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts, deciding which operations and methods to use and why.
Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 .
Use place value, known and derived facts to \times and divide mentally, including multiplying by 0 and 1, dividing by 1, multiplying together three numbers.
Recognise and use factor pairs and commutativity in mental calculations.
Multiply 2-d and 3-d numbers by a 1-d number using formal written layout.
Solve problems involving \times and $+$, including using the distributive law to \times 2-d numbers by a 1-d.
