Weeks 1-3: Multiplication and division

We will be:

- Recalling and using multiplication facts for the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables
- Solving problems involving multiplication and division using materials, arrays, repeated addition and mental methods, including problems in context.
- Showing that multiplication can be done in any order and that division cannot.

Weeks 4 and 5: Addition and Subtraction: Inverse relations

We will be:

- Recognising and using the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and using this to check calculations and solve missing number problems.

Weeks 6 and 7: Measurement

- Choosing and using appropriate measures to measure length and weight.

Topic:

We will be learning all about Guy Fawkes' plan to blow up the houses of parliament and thinking about how and why we still remember this event today.
