

Maths

Weeks 1-2 Time

Children will be learning how to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour. They will compare and measure quantities of time as well as be using the language relating to dates, days of the week, weeks, months and years.

Week 3 Place Value

We will continue to embed the children's knowledge of the number system and quantity of numbers within 0 to 100.

Week 4-5 Addition and Subtraction

We will continue to practise solving addition and subtraction calculations as well as developing the children's reasoning and problem solving skills.

Week 6 Measure

Here children will be solving practical problems when comparing heights and lengths.

Topic

Our topic work this half term will be based around superheroes. We will be making many cross curricular links so that children can think about what it takes to be a superhero for example what qualities should a superhero have? What would a healthy lifestyle look like for a superhero? Where in the world might a superhero need to travel? We also have lots of exciting computing, PE, and RE lessons to look forward to.
