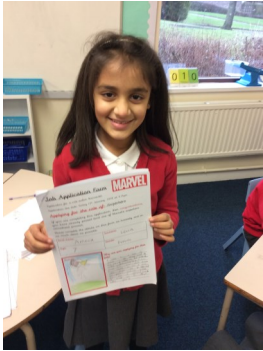
This week the children have been enjoying their gymnastics lessons with Mrs Armitage. They have been practising their balancing skills and exploring one point balances.

Y1/2



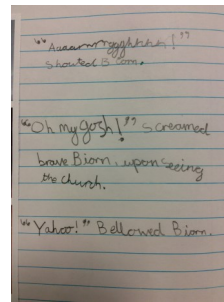
