

History

We will be finding out about popular toys from the 20th and early 21st century this half term. We will be thinking about toys that are popular today, before moving on to find out about toys that were popular when our parents and grandparents were children. We will develop a range of historical skills such as: asking and answering questions, identifying and interpreting different sources, recognising change and exploring how this influences us today.

Children will be investigating the four operations and the ways these are all linked. They will continue to develop their problem solving and reasoning skills throughout.
