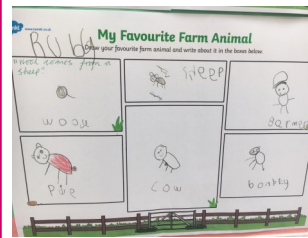
Read all about us...
