We also had a class discussion about what we like/dislike about the story and what we

Y2/3W

Year 2/3W have had another amazing week. In writing, they completed their 'Hot Write', writing their own story about a monster. They worked hard to include all the elements from our character toolkit. In History, we learnt about how the Gunpowder Plot changed England. In art, we experimented with different drawing pencils and drew the final sections of the Houses of Parliament. We used charcoal to add shading and tone to our picture. We then used watercolours to create a background before adding extra detail by layering pastel colours over the top. I hope you all have a great weekend!

Y4 We have had another great week in Year 4. In math, we have converted improper fractions to mixed numbers and in writing, written a fantastic recount of "The Lamb Who Came to Dinner." In reading, we have looked at extracts from "Peter Pan" and the Poem "The Shadow" by Robert Louis Stevenson. We have been perfecting our dance in P.E. ready to perform next week and learnt all about how to be safe on the internet, earning ourselves a Delta Stars card. Have a lovely weekend.

Y6 This week in year 6 has been Autumn 2's testing week and the children have displayed a wonderful attitude to their test papers - they are on track to be amazing in May. As well as this, in writing, we have started to write setting descriptions based on the wintery scenes in Charles Dicken's Christmas Carol. In maths, we have learnt how to find a percentage of an amount and how to find 100% if we are given a percentage of an amount. In the afternoons, we have been learning how to paint shadows on focal points, learning about the geographical features of Antarctica and how to play Jingle Bells in music. FS2 We have had a very exciting and busy week this week! On Monday when we entered the classroom, we were greeted by 2 elves with a special delivery- a Christmas tree and decorations!
